



North Carolina Association of Senior Citizen Clubs Inc. Scholarship Application

Scholarship Program Guidelines

Student applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for the **North Carolina Association of Senior Citizen Clubs, Inc. Scholarship.**

Purpose: To Award a scholarship to college-bound high school seniors attending Historically Black Colleges or Universities (HBCUs).

Criteria:

- (1) A student eligible for Scholarship Award must be a graduating high school senior who resides in North Carolina and intends to continue their education at a HBCU four-year college or university.
- (2) Submit a minimum of two recommendation letters from (i.e., a pastor, teacher, employer, supervisor, etc.).
- (3) Submit a well-written, meaningful essay, not to exceed 500 words. Subject (see below in application).
- (4) Students should submit a scholarship application on the form provided by the North Carolina Association of Senior Citizen Clubs, Inc. Applications may be downloaded from **www.ncascc.com**.
- (5) Student must have a High School Graduating GPA of **2.5 and above** (submit transcript).

Scholarship Priorities:

Submit all completed applications to the North Carolina Association of Senior Citizen Clubs, Inc. Scholarship Committee by the deadline of June 30th of the present year.

* The NCASCC will use the postmarked date to determine mailed entries.

Amount: Each scholarship awarded will be a maximum of \$500, which will be awarded after June 30th of the present year.

Renewal process: This scholarship is non-renewable.

Only high school seniors intending to enroll in a HBCU four-year college or university are eligible.

Previous scholarship recipients cannot re-apply.
